Upon moving back to the mainland, Evan got more involved in adaptive athletics and started excelling specifically in snowboarding. He found support through key organizations like Adaptive Action Sports in Summit County, CO, and through his friends and family.

Evan exemplifies perseverance, positive attitude, and hard work. In March of 2014, Evan won the gold medal in snowboard cross in Sochi, Russia representing the United States and his home town of Nevada City, California in the International Paralympic event. Nevada City is honored to welcome home our gold medalist and we are asking for your help to fund a celebration parade to recognize him for his outstanding achievement!

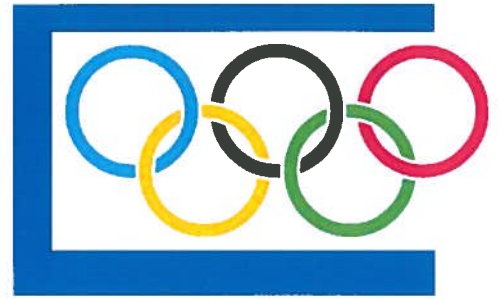
