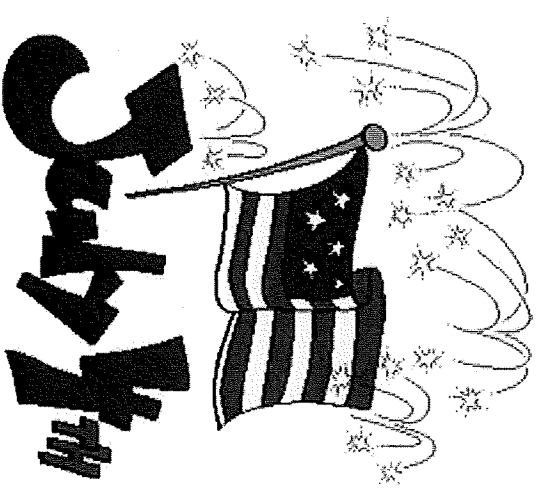

4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION

Craft vendors are invited to participate in this one-day event that attracts approx. 7,000 people.

DATE: July 4, 2018 (Wednesday)

TIME: 3pm -10pm

ENTRY FEE: \$85

BOOTH SPACE: 10' x 10'

PLACE: Nevada County Fairgrounds
11228 McCourtney Rd, Grass Valley

SET-UP: 12:00 Noon - 2:30pm – You **MUST**

Off-load your vehicle as quickly as possible and move it to the parking lot. **All vehicles MUST be off the fairgrounds by 2:30pm. No early or late set-ups allowed.** Enter the fairgrounds from McCourtney Road Gate 4 and proceed to the back of the fairgrounds to Gate 5. Check in with gate monitor.

NO PARKING ON THE GRASS AT ANY TIME

All booth lights must be turned off when fireworks begin.

TAKE DOWN: After the fireworks approx. 10pm. No vehicles allowed on the fairgrounds before this time and must be off the grounds by 11:30pm - **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

PASSES: With paid vendor fee you receive Two (2) Gate passes (wristbands) and One (1) Parking pass for each booth space purchased. Extra gate passes for booth volunteers may be purchased in advance for \$4 each.

A California Sales Permit is required. Apply online at www.boe.ca.gov or in person at State Board of Equalization, 3321 Power Inn Rd #210, Sacramento, CA 95826 (916) 227-6700.

NOT ALLOWED

- 1) **NO FIREWORKS** of any kind are to be sold or brought onto the fairgrounds. No sparklers or explosive devices, including such items as poppers, streamers, confetti. No cans of "Silly String". Anything that causes litter/refuse/smoke is **not allowed.**
- 2) **NO ADULT NOVELTIES** are to be sold.
- 3) **NO TOY GUNS** are to be sold.
- 4) **NO NAILS** are to be hammered into any trees on the fairgrounds.
- 5) **NO ANIMALS** (except service dogs)
- 6) **NO PARKING ON THE GRASS!!**

Any violation of these rules will automatically exclude vendor from participation in the 4th of July event for the remainder of the day & from future events.

TRASH: There will be large garbage bins near the arena and Gate 8. **DO NOT** fill up garbage cans near your booth.

FAIRGROUNDS CAMPING: If you wish to park an RV or camp at the Fairgrounds, reservations must be made through the Fairgrounds by calling (530) 273-6217. Space is limited. There is a fee.

INSURANCE: Proof of Insurance (Certificate of Liability) **MUST** accompany the vendor application. Minimum \$1,000,000 liability naming the 4th of July Committee & Nevada County Fairgrounds as additional insured. If you do not have insurance, call Libby for purchasing insurance through the event. Crafters: \$22.00, Food Vendors: \$33.00

4th of July State Fire Marshal Compliance Procedure

1. All vendors will have a structure that is fire retardant treated or permanently tagged by the manufacturer and inherently fire resistant. CPAI-84 is a specification written especially for materials used in tents that should be tagged on the tent.

If the manufacturer does not tag your booth, you may treat it yourself and you are required to do so. We suggest you maintain a folder with photos of the material being treated with date stamps on the photos. Additionally have dated sales receipts for the fire retardant you purchased. These will need to be presented to the Fire Marshal Inspector the day of the event.

If you are not compliant, you will not be allowed to be in the event. There will be an inspection the day of the event, so come prepared.

2. All booths must have a currently tagged fire extinguisher secured in plain sight inside booth. Fire extinguishers must be 2A 10BC rated.

3. Extension Cords will be heavy duty 3 wire "grounded" cords not in excess of 20' in length. Under no circumstances will any two wire cords be deployed in any booth or tent.
